

# Operating and Administrating a Continuum Security System

This course teaches students to operate and modify a fully-configured Continuum Security system. In addition, it teaches students how to use schedules, templates, menu pages, listviews, and graphic control panels. All topics include extensive hands-on use of the Continuum program

## Intended Audience

This hands-on 4 –day course covers the use of the *Continuum* Workstation from the perspective of the Security End-User. The class covers all aspects of operating a configured Continuum Security System as well as making modifications to that system. In addition, administrative tasks are also covered.

## Prerequisites

Basic computer skills, knowledge of Windows NT and/or 2000 environment.

## Course Description

Students learn the basics of the Continuum product, the operation of the Continuum workstation and the Andover Controls philosophy for facility integration. They will be able to use the Continuum workstation to operate a configured Continuum Security system. The course begins with an operator level overview of a fully configured system. Subsequently, the students will make configuration modifications to their own system through a series of challenging lab exercises.
